30km north of Wiarton, it surrounds West Little Lake, a pristine 70-acre spring-fed lake in a central location on the peninsula, close to both Lake Huron and Georgian Bay.



The lots at Lakewood are privately owned and set in a development that includes many acres of preserved green space. Footpaths and cedar boardwalks are available throughout the community common spaces and incorporate seating areas along the way. For those with a green thumb, enjoy tending to the community garden and growing your own seasonal fruits and vegetables. The local amenities are cooperatively owned and managed by the residents themselves.

West Little Lake provides a tranquil spot for canoeing, kayaking, rowing, or simply for quiet enjoyment. Only a short drive away are beautiful stretches of sandy beach found at Black Creek Provincial Park or the local beach in Lion's Head.
